**A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE THE BROOKHAVEN POLICE DEPARTMENT
(MUNICIPAL COURT) AN EMERGENCY TEMPORARY MEETING LOCATION OF
THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Georgia declared a state of emergency for the entire State of Georgia in response to the potential impact of Hurricane Irma; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven has experienced substantial impact from Hurricane Irma; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookhaven was to hold a regularly scheduled City Council meeting at Brookhaven City Hall, 4362 Peachtree Road NE, Brookhaven, Georgia 30319, beginning at 7:00 p.m. on September 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Brookhaven City Hall is without power as of 2:00 p.m. on September 12, 2017, rendering City Hall an imprudent location from which to conduct some public business and affairs of local government; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 38-3-54 requires that, when it becomes imprudent to conduct the affairs of local government at the regular or usual place thereof as the result of an emergency or natural disaster, the governing body must designate by ordinance, resolution, or other manner alternate or substitute sites as the emergency temporary location; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Brookhaven desire to conduct the regularly scheduled City Council meeting at the Brookhaven Police Department;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Brookhaven:

1. Brookhaven Police Department, Municipal Court Room, 2665 Buford Highway NE, Brookhaven, Georgia 30324, is hereby an emergency temporary location for the conducting of public business during an emergency or disaster situation.
