On June 12th, 2017, Officer McCoy responded to a call at the Post Brookhaven Apartments, where an armed robbery had just occurred. A call came out with the description of the suspect and Chatcomm advised that a second victim had been shot at and that the subject had run up the hill and out of site on Caldwell Road.

Officer McCoy spotted the subject fitting the description and he gave numerous verbal commands to the subject, who attempted to run off while trying to reach into his backpack. The subject ran between two houses and was stopped by a privacy fence, where he was apprehended and held at gun point by Officer McCoy until other officers arrived to assist with the arrest.

A check of the area was completed and the handgun used was found in the neighbor's yard on the other side of the fence, where it was thrown. The keys and the phones stolen were recovered and returned to the victim.

Officer McCoy's swift and professional actions resulted in the arrest of the subject. His actions are indicative of the level of character, training and experience which he possesses and is indicative of the caliber of personnel of the Brookhaven Police Department.
