

RESOLUTION NO. RES 2017-06-XX

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF NO LEFT TURN SIGNS
AT NORTHBOUND APPROACH TO THE ENTRANCE OF CAMBRIDGE SQUARE
ON ASHFORD DUNWOODY ROAD DURING EVENING RUSH HOUR**

WHEREAS: O.C.G.A. 40-6-371 empowers the City Council of the City of Brookhaven, Georgia to regulate traffic by means of official traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS: City of Council of the City of Brookhaven authorized Ashford-Dunwoody Corridor Study in late 2015 and the study was completed in early 2017; and

WHEREAS: City of Brookhaven is in the process of implementing study recommendations, and engineering and traffic analysis of the Ashford Dunwoody Road/Johnson Ferry Road Intersection (ST-01) requires installation of traffic control devices along Ashford Dunwoody Road; and

WHEREAS: The intersection of Ashford Dunwoody Road and the Cambridge Square entrances warrants No Left Turn between 4:00 PM and 7:00 PM signs based on limited traffic flow and vehicle and pedestrian safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKHAVEN, GEORGIA that the permanent installation of four no left turn sign on the northbound approach to the intersection of Ashford Dunwoody Road and the Cambridge Square entrance is authorized.
